Dear Lecturers and Contributors,

The Proceedings of the Carpathian Summer School of Physics 2007, Sinaia Aug 20-31, 2007 will be published in the *American Institute of Physics Conference Proceedings* series. The invited lectures and the oral contributions will be published in one volume.

The main terms of the contract we, L. Trache and S. Stoica as Volume Editors, undertook with AIP are summarized below:

The proceedings will be published as a **print book** and **online**. It will be an (about) 450-page book of the 6 x 9 inch format. A copy will be shipped to each participant. The price is for the book with black and white illustrations only. The online version will be published simultaneously with the print book at no extra charge, and all of the conference participants will have free access. Color figures will appear in the online version. Color can be added to the print version for an additional fee of \$204 per color page. Generally, authors are charged directly if they wish to have color printing in their papers. All the original graphics submitted in color will be converted to black and white for the print book, if not arranged otherwise. However, color will be included without additional charge in the online version.

The printed book will have the Volume number in the AIP Conference Proceedings Series, ISSN and ISBN, and will be registered at the Library of Congress. It will have AIP's Copyright. AIP Conference Proceedings are indexed in ISI, INSPEC, SPIN, and Web of Science, participate in CrossRef and are searchable on Google.

According to the policies of AIP, we must ensure that the proceedings must contain a minimum 90% of lectures and contributions and is available in final form in 3 months after the end of the event. **Therefore, the typescripts, in camera ready electronic form, are due at the organizers by Nov. 1st, 2007.**

There will be a limitation in the number of pages for accepted typescripts:

- 9 pages for invited lectures
- 5 pages for contributions.

Instructions are included in this welcome package and will be posted on the web. A copyright transfer form is included. Please fill it and mail it to the Editors when you send in the typescript. If you chose to order reprints, please fill in the form included and send it directly to the publisher.

The Volume manuscripts must be prepared according to the *Author Instructions for AIP Conference Proceedings*. Detailed instructions to authors are available both as printed booklets and online as a PDF file. LaTeX and MS Word templates are available online at <http://proceedings.aip.org>.

TRANSFER OF COPYRIGHT AGREEMENT

Copyright to the above-listed unpublished and original article submitted by the above author(s), the abstract forming part thereof, and any subsequent errata (collectively, the "Article") is hereby transferred to the American Institute of Physics (AIP) for the full term thereof throughout the world, subject to the Author Rights (as hereinafter defined) and to acceptance of the Article for publication in a proceedings of AIP. This transfer of copyright includes all material to be published as part of the Article (in any medium), including but not limited to tables, figures, graphs, movies, and other multimedia files. AIP shall have the right to register copyright to the Article in its name as claimant, whether separately or as part of the conference proceedings or other medium in which the Article is included.

The author(s), and in the case of a Work Made For Hire, as defined in the U.S. Copyright Act, 17 U.S.C. § 101, the employer named below, shall have the following rights (the "Author Rights"):

- (1) All proprietary rights other than copyright, such as patent rights.
(2) The nonexclusive right, after publication by AIP, to give permission to third parties to republish print versions of the Article or a translation thereof, or excerpts therefrom, without obtaining permission from AIP, provided the AIP-prepared version is not used for this purpose, the Article is not published in another conference proceedings or journal, and the third party does not charge a fee. If the AIP version is used, or the third party republishes in a publication or product charging a fee for use, permission from AIP must be obtained.
