

Postdoctoral Positions
Texas A&M University Cyclotron Institute

Applications are invited for postdoctoral positions in experimental nuclear physics at the Texas A&M University Cyclotron Institute. Initial appointments will be for one year with normal renewal for one or two additional years. The scientific program at the Institute is built around a K500 superconducting cyclotron. Ancillary equipment includes a high-resolution spectrometer, a recoil ion spectrometer, a fast tape-transport with detectors for high-precision decay studies, and high efficiency arrays for detecting neutrons, gamma rays, and charged particles. One position is immediately available in the Weak Interactions Group of Professor John Hardy. Positions may also be available in other areas of interest in the laboratory in the near future.
