1. **Deadline**: send you review article **before February the 14th, 2006** to the editorial committee of your section.
2. **Length**: papers should not exceed **14 pages** using the EPJ L^AT_EX 2e macro package available via anonymous ftp from the ftp server :

<ftp.edpsciences.org> in the directory /pub/epj

3. **What to send**: please send a compressed zip or tar.gz file containing the L^AT_EX file, all figure files, and a pdf or ps file of the complete article including figures.
4. All chapters will be reviewed in order to insure the homogeneity and coherence of the book. However all authors are encouraged to read the manuscripts available on the WCI website <http://cyclotron.tamu.edu/wci3/> and send comments and suggestions both to the authors and to the editorial committee concerned.
5. In the redaction of your chapter please take into account the following:
 - Each section should be a synthetic and exhaustive review of the subject discussing :
 1. the scientific goals
 2. the achievements obtained
 3. the possible disagreements and a road map to solve them
 4. the key issues and future developments
 - Privilege summarizing figures and tables by grouping the results of a maximum of published papers from different groups
 - Seminal measurement, best examples may be an interesting complement
 - Each section should contain a perspectives part stressing the goals and assessing the needs (apparata, human resources,...) of possible future developments.
